2. On-Spot Registration:

Available on May 20, 2025, until 4:00 PM.

3. Mandatory Registration Documents:

- All teams must submit a hard copy of the entry form at registration.

4. Final Registration Deadline:

No new players can be added or replaced after the final registration deadline.

5. Bracket Draw:

Tournament brackets will be drawn on May 30, 2025, at 7:00 PM.

Referees & Officials

6. Referee Certification:

Only referees who pass the written and practical exam will receive a diploma.

7. Accommodation & Benefits for GFI Referees:

 GFI will provide free hotel, meals, and remuneration for selected referees (Category 4, 3, 2, and 1).

9. Technical Officials' Dress Code:

13. Medals Distribution:

14. Dress Code:

All participants must wear neat and clean GFI-approved attire.

15. Personal Equipment:

 Participants must bring their own grappling gear and protective guards, as per GFI rules.

16. Match Suspension & Termination:

 The tournament officials have the right to suspend or terminate matches, players, or teams for rule violations.

17. Right to Refuse Entry:

 The organizing committee reserves the right to accept or reject any team or individual's entry.

18. Merging of Categories:

 If there are fewer than three entries in an event, the technical committee may adjust with a joint category.
